In any disaster, what we all want and need is up-to-date information we can trust. We were reminded of that during the fires last Fall. What made everything so much worse was the lack of information.

The STCEVC Emergency Communications Committee continues to work on a South County emergency communications protocol, but in the meantime, below are information sources that can be helpful during a disaster.

I urge you to sign-up immediately for the following:

### **NIXLE**

NIXLE notifications are sent for weather alerts, road closures and emergency updates during a disaster:

- **Tillamook County:** <https://local.nixle.com/city/or/tillamook/>  
At the top of the page, you will see a green sign-up button, click on it and complete your registration. OR You can text your zip code to 888-777 (rates may apply).
- **Lincoln County:** <https://www.co.lincoln.or.us/emergencymanagement/page/lincoln-alerts-emergency-notifications-and-community-information>  
Click on option 2 and complete your registration. OR You can text 888-777 (rates may apply) and type in Lincoln City.

### **EVERBRIDGE**

EVERBRIDGE notifications are sent for weather alerts and emergency updates.
